

Evaluation of the Seminar, 4th November 2011

During the presentation market all participants were asked to give a feedback to the seminar. Two flipcharts were prepared and put in a separate room

- to “mark” ones assessment concerning a choice of aspect and
- to comment freely on the experiences.

The results of this feedback are shown below. The “spider`s net” shows a mainly positive feedback to all aspects presented. The school visits and the atmosphere of the seminar were assessed positively by all participants. Positive comments were given to the chance to meet people from different countries all over Europe and about the subjects and results of the workshops.

Some critical comments were given too, e.g. to the food, the standard of the recommended hotel, the duration of the seminar and a lack of working material. Regrettably the authors of these remarks did not talk to the organizing team of the seminar directly. Participants asked by the moderators personally expressed confidence with the hotel and the food. The organizers of the seminar offered to send additional material if participants tell concrete wishes with reference to the seminar topics.

In the written and oral comments the participation of students in the seminar, the warm atmosphere, and the international cooperation was praised. Many participants expressed their appreciation also during the farewell dinner.
